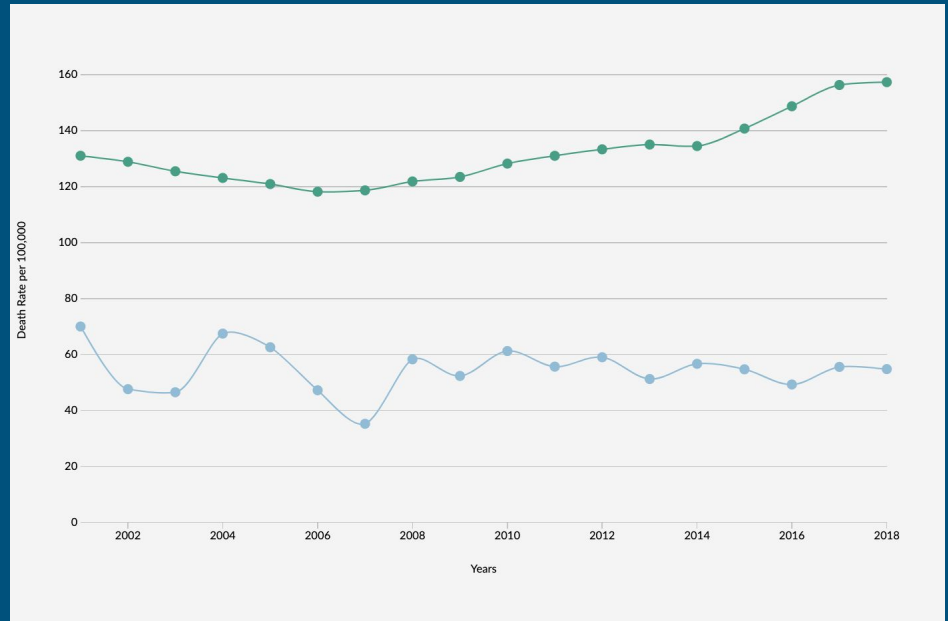

- Federal?

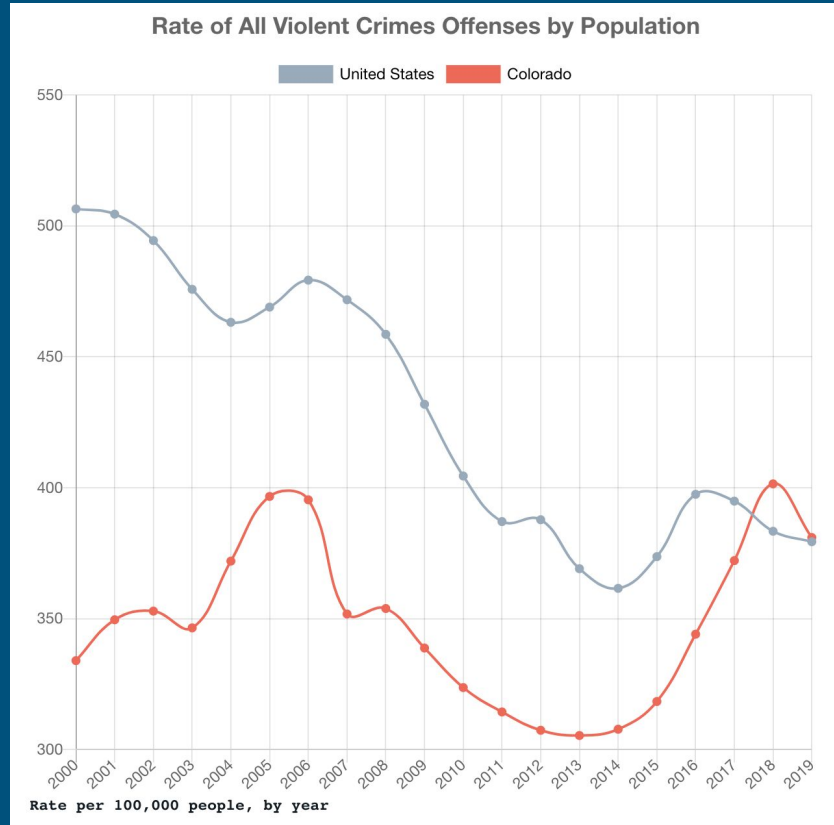
Red Flag Laws

Measuring crude death rate per 100,000 of suicide firearm deaths





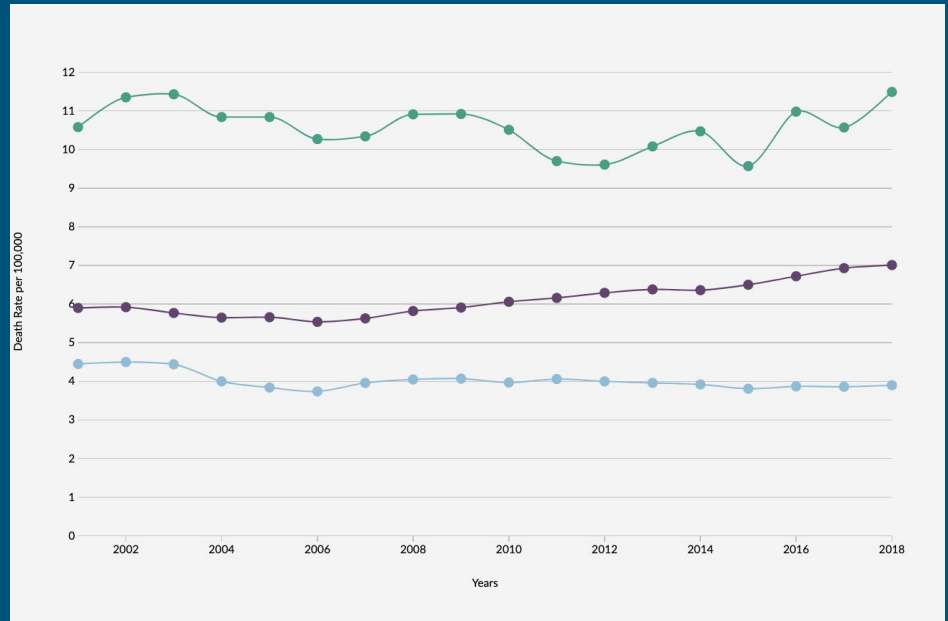
'Shall-issue' to 'may-issue'
